

Mumbai, located in the state of Maharashtra, is the financial capital of India and most companies have head offices here.



Maharashtra's gross state domestic product accounted for 14.20% of India's GDP in 2021-22, the highest among all Indian states.



Major automotive companies like Piaggio, General Motors, Fiat India, Mercedes-Benz, Premier Automobiles, Jaguar & Land Rover, Volkswagen India, Bajaj Auto, Force Motors and Mahindra Navistar are based in Pune, only 150 km from Mumbai. The Mumbai/Pune car-manufacturing cluster contributes to 33% of the Indian market.
